Technics: mechanical soil working and controlled natural grassing

Grape harvest: mechanical harvest

Vinification: fermentation on thermoregulation

Maturing: on lees

Alcohol by vol: 13%

Type: rosé wine

Grapes variety: pinot gris

Conditioning: box of 6 or 12 bottles and BIB of 5L

Capacity: 75cL or BIB of 5L

Bottled: at the domain

Robe: coppery pink

Nose: peach, rose petal

Flavors: fresh, fruity

Serve with: aperitif, starter, barbecue, poultry, quiches

Serving temperature: 8-10°C

Keeping period: 3 to 4 years
